

## Rules and Regulations

1. Every class which is offered herein will be conducted and judged under the current rules of the United States Equestrian Federation.
2. Life, Senior active and Junior active Members shall be eligible to participate at Regular Member Competitions. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Member Competitions upon payment of a \$30 registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the requirements of this rule: 1)leadline, 2)exhibitions, 3)games and races, 4)classes for 4-H members, 5)walk, trot, and academy classes (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program), 6)opportunity classes and 7)citizens of other nations who are members in good standing of their national federation and have proof in English.

Hunter Breeding entries close the Monday before the show. No post entries.

If Classes are not filled, post entries will be accepted up to one hour before the class at an additional \$25 for sections requiring a combined entry fee, \$15 for each class offering prize money and \$10 for each class not offering prize money. All accounts must be settled by 6:00pm Sunday of each show. Open checks will be filled in at that time.

4. REFUNDS on entries will be made only upon receipt of veterinarian certificates attesting to inability of horse do to illness or injury to participate. Refunds will be mailed. There will be a \$25 office charge for all refunds.
5. Amateur certification and Pony and Junior Hunter measurements cards must be presented at the Show Office before numbers will be given out.
6. No entry will be accepted unless signed by the owner/agent and coach/trainer and the required fees in negotiable funds accompany a completed entry blank.
7. Stalls will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis. Stalls are in a permanent barn with doors. \$50 per day.
8. In order to remove any animal or equipment from show grounds, a release must be obtained from the Show Secretary.
9. All prize money will be paid by check and may be picked up at the Secretary's Office a half hour after the completion of a division. The horse show's responsibility terminates at that time. All checks will be void after 30 days.
10. Rider or trainer conflicts will not be honored.
11. Dogs and other pets must be on a leash at all times.
12. Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes.
13. Management reserves the right to limit courtesy circles.
14. The Long Island Horse Show Inc. and Old Field Farm Ltd., management, their officials and employees shall not be liable for any injury to a person or property of any exhibitor, rider, spectator, visitor, groom or any other person by reason of any event occurring during the course of the shows.
15. Should any questions arise that are not provided in the rules, the same shall be referred to the Show Committee whose decision shall be final.

16. Negative Coggins Test dated within the calendar year required.
17. A fee of \$50 plus collection fees will be charged for all non-negotiable checks. Exhibitors who submitted non-negotiable checks in previous years must pay cash for entries.
18. Rings are: Main Ring- 260 x 170 All weather footing- Outside course & Pony course are grass/sand- 250 x 165. Schooling ring 110x220 sand.
19. Seats in Grandstand are available-contact Old Field Farm 631-246-8983.
20. All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, Jumper & hunter seat eq. (except those activities enumerated in GR 901.1 items 1-9 must be properly identified & must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA.
21. Horses must be entered in the horse show in order to enter warm-ups.
22. Veterinary measurements will be done by appointment. Please call 516-297-1539.
